The student may attend public school, a private school, or be home schooled as long as the residency requirement is met.

The award will be paid directly to the financial aid department of the college/university where the applicant has been accepted and plans to attend. The money is to be used for tuition, room and board, fees, books, or any other legitimate educational expense. The amount of the award is \$2,500.
